

Lawn treatment

Time to Work and Products

Our lawn product takes up to 6 weeks to work. Most of the time you will not see progress until 3 weeks after treatment. This is normal! The treatment is designed to work slowly, allowing turf grass to fill into the gaps where the weeds have died.

Mowing and Turf Types

Please do not mow your lawns for 7 days after treatment and 14 days is even better. Mowing promotes growth and will affect the product's uptake into the plant dramatically. The product is safe on all types of turf including: Buffalo, Kikuyu, Couch and Queensland Blue.

People/Pets and Drying Time

The lawns are safe to be used again once the product is dry and has been absorbed by the plant. This can take between 1 hour and 4 hours, and really depends on the weather on the day (the warmer the better). Please use common sense and ensure the lawns are dry before use

Weather

Our lawn product is very effective even when rain is expected, generally only needing an hour without rain for the treatment to be successful.

Weeds it kills and weeds it doesn't

The product we use is a selective broadleaf weed killer. It safely removes almost every type of broadleaf weed including bindii, clover capeweed, dandelion and oxalis to name only a few. It won't kill grass weed types including Winter Grass and Silver Grass, and has no effect on bulbous weeds including Guildford/Onion Grass.

Will the Weeds Come Back?

No. Will you get new weeds from new seeds next year? Probably. Unfortunately, most weed seeds have a 'shelf' life of up to 7 years. The war on weeds is always a marathon and not a sprint.

Fertilising

We recommend waiting 6 weeks after treatment before fertilising.



Allow 3 – 6 weeks to see the progress of our lawn treatment.



Do not mow your lawn until 7 – 14 days after your lawn treatment.



Treated lawn is safe for use after 1 – 4 hours drying time.
